Bible Academy Registration Schedule for Spring 2017

1001 – Introduction to the Bible

This course will introduce the sixty-six (66) books of the Bible, its origin, and the important events, periods, and personalities that led to the development of the Bible in its present form.

1007 – Introduction to the Old Testament

This course identifies methods and approaches to Bible study that can lead to spiritual growth and Christian maturity. Areas that will be covered include the structure of the Bible, resources for study and other related subjects.

1072 - Introduction to the New Testament

1075- The Synoptic Gospels

This course will focus on the Synoptic Gospels-- Matthew, Mark and Luke. Students will study the life and ministry of Jesus Christ as portrayed by these three writers. Through this comparative study, students will gain a more comprehensive understanding of Jesus' ministry.

2007 – Christian Stewardship
